During this time we will suspend all committee meetings and regular programs outside of Sunday morning.

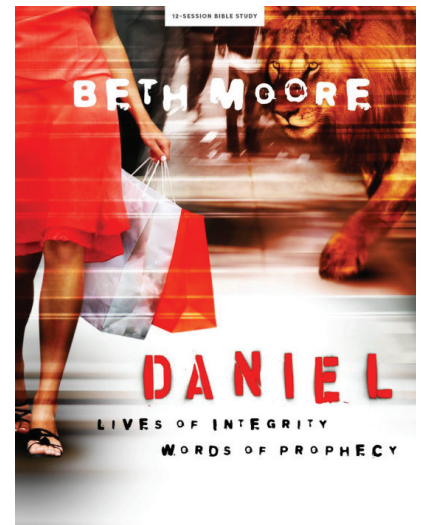
The church office will remain open and our staff and ministers will still be available.

BE A PRAYER PARTNER

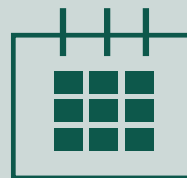
