DEBT RETIREMENT

This month, we are asking you to consider giving to our ongoing Debt Retirement efforts. This debt was created when we built the Family Life Center (with the Turner Gym, Ledford Welcome Center, portico and connecting corridor) and the Cashwell Handicap Corridor into the sanctuary, and also includes mortgages on our properties on White Oak Road. The original debt of \$3,746,344 has, thanks to many of you, been reduced to \$2,165,532. All monies collected will reduce the principal, thereby saving our church interest expenses. Remember: no gift too small, no gift too large, everyone participate!
