We have made great strides reducing our debt by more than \$1,200,000.00 over the past 7 years. The borrowed funds were used to construct additional facilities on our campus (the Family Life Center with the Dr. James B. Turner Gym, The Hubert and Lola Ledford Welcome Center with covered portico and the Dr. T. L. Cashwell Handicap Corridor into the sanctuary). We all use these additions so we hope everyone will participate in paying off this debt. There are "Debt Retirement" envelopes throughout the Church for your use.
