ABOUT TODAY'S WORSHIP

This weekend several members of HBBC Youth Choir are participating in SEGUE at Campbell University. The SEGUE festival is a one day, high energy event for youth choirs who are transitioning to the next level of ministry. In recent years we have hosted SEGUE Sunday here at Hayes Barton. This usually includes three or four choirs who have participated in the festival the previous day. Wake Forest Baptist Church is hosting SEGUE Sunday this year and our youth choir is participating as the combined choirs lead two worship services and a retirement center concert. We are grateful to Rev. Larry Ballard and Jackson Glover for their leadership in worship here at Hayes Barton today.

UPCOMING EVENTS

SCOUT SUNDAY

Today we honor BSA Troop 325, which has been chartered by HBBC since 1931. Currently, there are 48 active Boy Scouts and 23 active adult leaders in our troop. Collectively, our troop's active scouts have earned 691 merit badges since becoming scouts (296 are Eagle required merit badges), and have performed over 530 Service project hours for our communities.

DEBT RETIREMENT SUNDAY: FEBRUARY 25

Our church has set aside next Sunday, February 25, as Debt Retirement Sunday: a time for a report on our debt and to receive a special offering to reduce our debt. This debt was created when we built the Family Life Center (with the Turner Gym, Ledford Welcome Center, portico and connecting corridor) and the Cashwell Handicap Corridor into the sanctuary, and also includes mortgages on our properties on White Oak Road. The original debt of \$3,746,344 has, thanks to many of you, been reduced significantly. All monies collected will reduce the principal, thereby saving our church interest expenses. Remember: no gift too small, no gift too large, everyone participate!

WAY OF THE CHILD STUDY

During the season of Lent, our 3rd-5th graders are invited to participate in a special study starting today at 5 PM and ending on March 25. The Way of the Child walks through the events leading up to Jesus' death and resurrection and uses different mediums such as prayer, journaling, and art to help children connect with God in a meaningful way.
