JANUARY/FEBRUARY FAMILY NIGHTS

Family Night begins with our meal in the Fellowship Hall from 5:00-6:10 PM. The cost for the meal is \$6 for adults; \$4 for children (ages 3-12); under 2 are free. We accept cash, credit card, and checks. Bring your friends and family for a meal that's sure to satisfy the whole family. Afterward, we will break into various age groups. Preschoolers and children will head to music, the youth will join Point5 (a time of discipleship). Adults can choose from five small group opportunities.

Circle of Security (Room 204 / Hailey) - Parents are invited to learn about how secure parent-child relationships can be supported and strengthened.

Tooling Around with the Bible (Room 206 / The Well) - Learn to make Bible study more accessible through technology.

Sacred Rhythms (Room 200 / Koinonia) - Experience spiritual transformation through this study. Books are \$5 a person.

A Survey of the Gospel of Luke (January Sessions / Fellowship Hall) - Prepare for Sunday morning readings by surveying the narrative structure of Luke.

Worship Matters (February Sessions / Fellowship Hall) - Look back at how the Early Church (first Christians) worshiped and examine our current worship model.

Painting with Ches (Room 213 / Children's Multipurpose) - Develop creative talents our Heavenly Father has given us.
