## CELEBRATION SUNDAY TODAY

Today is Press on Toward the Goal Sunday and we are delighted that you are here to celebrate with us. During the worship service, we will each have the opportunity to submit our Estimate of Giving card as an act of worship. Following the worship service we will gather in the family life center for a delicious catered meal that is provided at no charge. ## JANUARY/FEBRUARY FAMILY NIGHTS
