DEACON ORDINATION SERVICE TODAY

Make plans to be part of this special service today at 3:00 PM as we will ordain and install our new Deacons who begin their three year service in 2019. What a special time it will be in the life of the church!

JANUARY/FEBRUARY FAMILY NIGHTS

Family Night begins with our meal in the Fellowship Hall from 5:00-6:10 PM. The cost for the meal is \$6 for adults; \$4 for children (ages 3-12); under 2 are free. We accept cash, credit card, and checks. Bring your friends and family for a meal that's sure to satisfy the whole family. Afterward, we will break into various age groups. Preschoolers and children will head to music, the youth will join Point5 (a time of discipleship).
