Last March our church received a report from our Long Range Capital Planning Committee. Included in this report were four recommended capital projects, all of which were received enthusiastically by our congregation. These capital planning projects include Sanctuary renovations with enlarged chancel; Kitchen expansion and fellowship hall improvements; Elevator to provide access to all levels in both chapel and educational buildings; Enhanced accessibility to nursery and chapel building with additional parking. SAVE THE DATE: 2019 SUMMER MISSION TRIPS

Although the weather is cold, it is time to start making summer plans. We are currently planning to send two adult/intergenerational mission teams into our world this summer. We will be partnering with Together for Hope Arkansas (CBF) and NC Baptist Men. Consider how you might be a part of one of these teams as we seek to transform lives through Christ.

Helena, Arkansas - July 13-19 - Team members will go to lead swim camp, blessings ministry, or construction. This will be our 16th year sending a mission team. It is a great way for families to serve together. Opportunities for teaching swim lessons (no experience required), working with preschoolers or children, visiting in the community, and construction work exist. The cost of the trip is \$710 per person and includes airfare, lodging,

most meals, transportation, insurance, and group costs. A non-refundable \$100 deposit will secure your spot.

Guatemala - August 17-23 - Team members will determine the nature of our work, but opportunities abound. There is a need for medical assistance, caring for orphans, construction, and more. The cost of the trip is \$1100 and includes airfare, supplies, transportation, meals, and lodging. A non-refundable deposit of \$150 will secure your spot.

FIVE POINTS 5K REGISTER NOW


