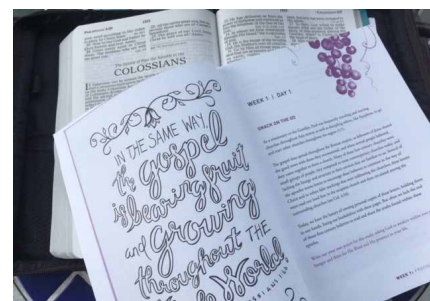


BAPTIST WOMEN'S GROUPS: SEPTEMBER 10

But considering all they have gone through and what they continue to have to do to remain—well I just have to say I think the Angels in Heaven were doing the Hokey Pokey with us that morning.

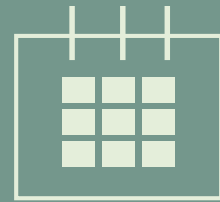
EVENING FITNESS
